The New Teacher Center and the Association of California School Administrators invite Leadership Coaches who have already participated

in the CLASS Workshop and who are engaged in leadership coaching to join the California Network of School Leadership Coaches. This ongoing community of practice is composed of individuals engaged in providing individualized coaching and support to beginning school administrators.

Background

The California Network of School Leadership Coaches began in 2002–03 as an ongoing community of practice composed of individuals engaged in providing individualized coaching and support to beginning school administrators. The network is both geared toward certification of California leadership coaches and to the continuous development of coaching skills for leadership coaches not seeking certification.

Intended Audience

Participants should have attended the New Teacher Center (NTC) training Coaching Leaders to Attain Student Success (CLASS) and must be engaged in leadership coaching of at least one site

administrator. It is not required that participants be actively coaching candidates for the Alternative Professional Clear Administrative Services Credential, to take the California Network seminars.

California Network of School Leadership Coaches is required for annual certification in all locally affiliated ACSA/NTC coaching programs.

Outcomes

Coaching is a complex endeavor that cannot be learned in one workshop; learning to coach is a lifetime enterprise. In creating this learning community, we work together to deepen our understanding of and ability to implement the concepts we learned in the California training. We use our own experiences, new training exercises, and research findings as we further develop our coaching skills. We problem-solve as a community and further build our profession as leadership coaches. Additionally, participants will work toward full certification as California leadership coaches.

Content

Problem-solve around coaching challenges; practice coaching skills; review articles that delve deeper into the content of the CLASS workshop; expand our knowledge of coaching skills, share programs and resource information. Learn to use the formative assessment tools that are part of the Alternative Professional Clear Administrative Services Credential.
