

Coaching & Observation Strategies

How do mentors collect and co-analyze classroom learning data with new teachers in ways that build professional trust and accountability? This **two-day workshop** builds participants' data collection, analysis, and interpretation skills. It walks through a classroom observation cycle and conversation protocols that become the foundation of coaching from observational data. Mentors will learn how to use teaching standards and various formative assessment tools to record data that can improve new teacher practice.

Who Should Attend

This workshop supports those who work with beginning teachers in the role of mentor, coach, university supervisor, master teacher, teacher leader, principal, and administrators of programs that provide support for beginning teachers.

Outcomes

- Examine the purposes and processes of the formative assessment observation cycle
- Learn and practice observation cycle conversation protocols
- Practice using Formative Assessment System (FAS) observation tools to collect and analyze evidence of instructional practice
