

# Designing Professional Development for New Teachers

This **two-day workshop** identifies and applies adult learning concepts and research-based professional development structures. It uses professional teaching standards to inquire into and develop learning experiences that meet new teacher needs. Participants will extend and refine their capacity to design and facilitate effective professional development.

## Who Should Attend

This workshop supports those who design and facilitate beginning teacher professional development events/programs. It is particularly useful for mentors and others who provide small or larger group professional development that is standards-based and geared toward meeting assessed needs.

## Outcomes

*Designing Professional Development for New Teachers* helps participants:

- Identify and understand assumptions about adult learning
- Use data to identify and strategies to address participating teachers' needs
- Use a conceptual framework for designing effective professional development
- Develop measurable field-based outcomes for professional development
- Use the inquiry cycle (Plan-Teach-Reflect) within the professional development context to create personal meaning and relevance
- Extend and refine group facilitation skills
- Create a draft plan for an upcoming professional development event
